

Will Saudi Arabia be able to deploy battery energy storage systems by 2030?

According to Saudi Energy Minister Prince Abdulaziz bin Salman, the nation has set a goal of deploying 48GWh of battery energy storage systems by 2030. This ambitious target not only supports Saudi Arabia's energy transition but also injects fresh momentum into the global renewable energy and energy storage markets.

Who is Saudi power procurement Company (SPPC)?

A Saudi Arabian entity that has been tasked with procuring electricity generation projects has commenced the process. Saudi Power Procurement Company (SPPC) is licensed as the sole buyer of electrical energy. The government is soliciting bids to develop four battery energy storage system (BESS) projects.

What is Saudi Arabia's battery storage program?

The projects mark the first phase of Saudi Arabia's ambitious battery storage program. It is designed to support its 50% renewable energy goal by 2030. Each 500 MW facility will operate for four hours, providing 2,000 MWh of total power capacity, said the SPPC.

Saudi Arabia's government entity tasked with procuring electricity generation projects has commenced the qualification process for a 2GW/8GWh battery storage tender. Saudi Power Procurement Company (SPPC), licensed as the sole buyer of electrical energy and capacity from sources within the Kingdom, made the announcement on Monday (4 November).

A list of pre-qualified bidders has been published in the first procurement of battery energy storage system (BESS) resources by the Saudi Power Procurement Company (SPPC). The state-owned SPPC announced the list earlier this week (30 December) for its forthcoming 2GW/8GWh build-own-operate (BOO) tender.

Battery storage presents a critical opportunity for the region to achieve its national renewable energy targets in the medium term, with the UAE aiming for net zero by 2050 and Saudi Arabia by 2060. Ensuring reliable and stable energy access is a top priority for governments in the Middle East, and batteries serve as enablers for energy consistency and reliability ...

In the UAE, the Emirates Energy Storage project, commissioned by the Emirates Water and Electricity Company (EWEC), is set to provide a capacity of 400 MW. According to reports, BMI forecasts rapid growth in the power storage sector over the next decade, driven primarily by the need for grid stabilisation and declining project costs.

The eco-friendly infrastructure includes renewable energy systems capable of providing clean power and sustainable water, generating 410,000 MWh per year; enough to power 10,000 households. A 700 MWh battery storage facility ensures 24/7 power, while a water desalination plant produces 37 million liters daily.
