Is there a 300MW solar PV plant in Mozambique?

Power project developer Ncondezi Energy has launched a feasibility study for a 300MW solar PV plant with battery storage, in Mozambique, Africa. The project will be located within Ncondezi's 25,000-hectare concession area in the Tete Province, with three preferred sites of c.500MW generation potential each already identified, the company said.

What is the largest power station in Mozambique?

The 2,075 megawatts Cahora Bassa Hydroelectric Power Station (CBHPS) across the Zambezi River, is the largest power station in Mozambique. As of 2019, Mozambique had 2,185 MW of installed hydroelectric generation capacity, accounting for 92 percent of total national installed capacity of 2,375 MW.

How many people in Mozambique have access to electricity?

According to the World Bank, only 30% of the Mozambican population had access to energy in 2017. Ncondezi has positioned itself as a contributor to Mozambique's goal of universal electricity access by 2030. Grid connections and electricity access are of large concern in southern Africa.
