

Mozambique EK New Energy Storage Project

Italian energy firm Eni is ready to take a final investment decision (FID) on its planned 3.4mn t/yr Coral Norte floating liquefaction (FLNG) terminal in Mozambique, should the project receive authorisation from the country's government, the firm has told Argus. Eni said it expects the government's approval to be "imminent", although it did not provide a...

Towards the end of 2023, power company Suomen Voima, which already owns five hydropower plants in Norway, announced its intention to develop a new energy storage project: Noste, in Northern Finland. They will construct up to three small-scale PSH plants, for a total capacity of more than 100MW and a total investment of up to EUR300 million.
