

What are the main sources of energy in Nepal?

Nepal has no known deposits of oil, gas, or coal except for some lignite deposits.² Biomass, oil products, coal, hydro, and electricity are its main sources of primary energy.

How much electricity does Nepal use?

15,000 MW of electricity, increase per capita electricity to 1,500 kWh and decrease the commercial energy use per unit of GDP from 3.20 ToE/mRs in 2015 to 3.14 ToE/mRs in 2030 (Source: Nepal's Sustainable Development Goal, Ba)

Who imports petroleum products in Nepal?

All the petroleum products consumed in Nepal are imported from the Indian Oil Corporation under a 5-year contract agreement signed on 27 April 2012. The Nepal Oil Corporation, a state-owned trading company established in 1980, imports, transports, stores, and distributes all petroleum products in the country.
