

New lithium battery production plant in Pács Hungary

Will SK On Hungary build a new lithium-ion battery plant?

In December 2021, Hungary notified the Commission of its plans to grant EUR209 million to support SK On Hungary in the construction of a new plant for the manufacturing of lithium-ion battery cells and battery modules for electric vehicles. The plant will have an annual capacity of 30 GWh and is expected to create at least 1,900 direct jobs.

Which companies make lithium-ion batteries in Hungary?

Today, Samsung SDI and SKI Innovation operate several giant factories in Hungary, whose total production will potentially grow to 47.3 GWh by 2025 and up to 87.3 GWh by 2030. GS Yuasa also produces automotive lithium-ion starter batteries, while Inzi Control also manufactures battery modules.

Will Hungary become a global hub of lithium-ion battery manufacturing?

The 7.3 billion euro (\$7.9 billion) factory will be one of Hungary's largest-ever foreign investments, and the government hopes it will make the Central European country a global hub of lithium-ion battery manufacturing in an era where governments are increasingly seeking to limit greenhouse gas emissions by switching to electric cars.

Who manufactures Car batteries in Hungary?

GS Yuasa also produces automotive lithium-ion starter batteries, while Inzi Control also manufactures battery modules. Many of the significant suppliers of the battery industry in Hungary are located directly near the main car manufacturing plants.

Will semcorp build a lithium ion battery factory in Hungary?

Semcorp lithium ion battery factory may be built in the second half of 2022 in Hungary. Last November, Foreign Minister Péter Szijjártó announced that Semcorp would build a factory in the Southern Industrial Park, in Debrecen, Hungary.

Where are lithium-ion batteries made?

Lithium-ion batteries will be assembled in a new plant with lithium-ion cells made in Japan. These batteries will be used for SLI (Starting, Lighting, and Ignition) applications which are expected to be expanded in the European market. GS Yuasa will also consider manufacturing lithium-ion cells in this plant in future.

The Pács plant has nearly 300 employees and 335,000 square feet of manufacturing and operational space. It is outfitted for PCBA production, machine work, equipment testing, mechanical assembly capabilities and special processes. The facility also produces Soundcraft mixers and Martin lighting products in addition to Studer consoles.
