Can solar panels be mounted on a roof?

The amount of setback depends on how much of the roof is covered by the panels. When the panels cover 33 percent or less of the plan view roof area, the panels must be set back from the ridge at least 18 in. (457 mm).



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When the panels cover more than 33 percent of the roof, the setback is increased to a minimum of 36 in. (914 mm).

Conversely, if the distance is too great, the cooling effect of plants on PV panels may be diminished. PV panels are commonly installed at distances ranging from 0.18 m to 1 m from the roof plane, with their performance contingent upon factors such as roof wind speed, selected plant species and height, and PV module material.
