Will Corvus build a battery factory in Bergen?

The battery factory in Bergen will supply Corvus' largest market--the growing European market--and contribute to employment in Bergen and across Northern Europe. Built on time and on budget, the factory comprises a robotized and digitized production line with nine robotic stations and a capacity of up to 400 megawatt hours (MWh) per year.

Why is a maritime cluster important in Norway?
