All outdoor low-voltage transformers and fixtures must be placed at least 5 feet from any pool or area of water, as stated in 680.22(A)(6). 680.23(A)(2) states that any transformer used to power underwater lights must be listed for pool or spa use. Try to match the size of the hole to your outdoor electrical box (usually about 2 1/8 inches wide). For precision, hold the outdoor socket box flush to the exterior wall where you want to insert it and create an outline using a pencil.
