

Where is Pakistan's nuclear power plant located?

The Karachi nuclear power plant, known as KANUPP, is located approximately 18km east of Karachi on the Arabian Sea coast. It has been in service since 1972 with a single 137MW reactor unit. The \$10bn project was built with financial assistance from China, the biggest energy and infrastructure investor in Pakistan.

When was Pakistan's first nuclear power plant built?

Pakistan's first Nuclear Power Plant, KANUPP Unit 1 of 137 MWe, was constructed in the outskirts of Karachi and achieved its first criticality on 1 st August, 1971. After 50-year of successful commercial operation, KANUPP Unit 1 power station was permanently shut-down on August 1, 2021 and is being decommissioned.

What is the Karachi nuclear power plant?

The Karachi nuclear power plant originally consisted of a 137MW single unit Canada Deuterium Uranium (CANDU) pressurised heavy-water reactor. This reactor, supplied by the Canadian General Electric Company, was fuelled by 30t of natural uranium and had a thermal output of 432.8MWt and gross electrical output of 137MWe.

General Electric (CGE) submitted a firm proposal.² On May 24, 1965 the Pakistan Atomic Energy Commission signed a turnkey project contract with CGE where CGE agreed to design, supply, construct, and commission a 137 MWe CANDU type nuclear power plant close to the city of Karachi. This became known as the Karachi Nuclear Power Plant, or KANUPP.
