Can I get a grant if I install solar panels in Spain?

If you install solar panels in Spain and apply for EU funding before 31st December 2023 you can receive EUR3,000 in grants. But note that the grant of 600 EUR/kWp is also only available for solar panel installations in Spain with a kWp under 10.

Are solar panels eco-friendly in Spain?

It means the carbon footprint of manufacturing 16 solar panels is equivalent to the carbon footprint of 3 kWh in Spain - most detached homes here will consume 3 kWh by midday in a single day.
