Do flat roof solar panels require ballasting?

Flat roof solar panels do not typically attach directly to the roof, so mounting frames must be weighted down using ballast. The roof structure must be able to support the ballast. If the system is fixed to the roof, it's essential to check the impact on the roof warranty and ensure water tightness is maintained.
