Despite its size, Port Vila possesses a number of important physical assets including the Bauerfield International Airport, Central Hospital, a campus of the University of the South Pacific, the National Vanuatu Museum, and the port of Port Vila which processes nearly 70 percent of the country's imports. Port Vila retains its historic ...

Many ports are installing solar PV arrays to generate as much of their own clean energy as possible. However, ports are 24-hour operations, and clearly solar does not provide power at night. A battery energy storage system solves this issue as it can store surplus solar energy generated during the day and provide it during hours of darkness.

As discussed briefly in the Economy & Livelihood section, Port Vila, and Vanuatu more generally, maintains a large trade imbalance and lacks local economic complexity.
