Why is PNG important for US exports?

The Wafi-Golpu Copper and Gold Mine, Porgera Gold Mine, and the development of the P'nyang LNG project provide opportunities for U.S. exports in heavy machinery, trucks, and other mining and energy equipment. Where is Papua New Guinea located?

Papua New Guinea (PNG for short) occupies the eastern half of the island of New Guinea (the western part belongs to Indonesia). The energy sector is under the control of the Department of Petroleum and Energy (DPE), through two main divisions: Petroleum Division (oil and gas) and Energy Division (electricity and renewables).

What resources does PNG have?

PNG has enormous mineral and gas reserves. The government relies on its natural resources for revenue and export earnings. Mineral exports from PNG include gold, copper, silver, nickel, and cobalt.

Who owns power in PNG?

PPL, the state-owned power utility, owns 440 MW of capacity, including 65% of hydro and geothermal. Oil Search and ExxonMobil dominate the oil and gas sector. PNG's power grid is fragmented and suffers from frequent outages. Oil and gas represent 64% of the power mix. Total energy consumption is predominantly made up of oil and biomass.

Who controls the energy sector in PNG?

The energy sector is under the control of the Department of Petroleum and Energy (DPE), through two main divisions: Petroleum Division (oil and gas) and Energy Division (electricity and renewables). PPL, PNG Power Limited, is the integrated state-owned power company.
