All other things being equal, at 24V the current will be half that at 12V. Large currents result in large resistive



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losses (heat) in wiring ($P = I^2 \cdot R$, so 2x the current means 4x the losses), but more importantly those losses cause voltage drop. By the time 12V at the battery gets to the inverter it might be only 11.5V, for example.
