Does Saudi Arabia have a battery energy storage system?

The contracts cover five separate 500 MW/2,500 MWh storage projects across Saudi Arabia, with sites in Riyadh, Qaisumah, Dawadmi, Al Jouf, and Rabigh. The Saudi Electricity Company (SEC) has awarded a series of battery energy storage system (BESS) contracts to China's BYD totalling 2.5 GW/12.5 GWh, multiple Chinese media reported on January 11.

Why is Saudi Arabia launching a battery storage project?

Saudi Arabia aims to generate 50% of its electricity from renewables by 2030. However, renewable energy sources like solar and wind can be unpredictable. The 12.5 GWh battery storage project will solve this issue by storing energy and ensuring a steady power supply. This is very important in Saudi Arabia.

Will China supply battery energy storage equipment to Saudi Arabia?

Under the contract, the Chinese firm will supply battery energy storage system (BESS) equipment to Saudi Arabia for storing electricity generated from renewable sources like solar, wind. The equipment supplied by BYD Energy Storage will be installed at five sites in the country.
