

How much will Romania pay for a battery energy storage system?

Romania has launched a new subsidy scheme for behind-the-meter battery energy storage systems to the tune of EUR 150 million (\$158 million). With the funding secured from the Modernization Fund, the Ministry of Energy launched the competitive bidding call on Tuesday. Bids will be accepted until January 17, 2025.

Does Romania have a grant program for battery energy storage systems?

The Romanian Ministry of Energy has launched a grant program for battery energy storage systems developed in conjunction with existing renewable energy facilities - wind, solar, or hydro. Romania has launched a new subsidy scheme for behind-the-meter battery energy storage systems to the tune of EUR 150 million (\$158 million).

What is Enery doing in Romania?

This week, Vienna-based Enery has commissioned a major solar and storage site in northwestern Romania. The project consists of a 51.4 MW PV plant and a battery energy storage facility of 22 MWh.

What is Romania's most important energy project?

Earlier this month, Burduja reported progress on what he terms as "the most important project for the Romanian energy system" - the 1 GW Tarnita-Lapustesti pumped storage hydropower plant. Romania resumed the development of the project last year, upping the planned capacity from 500 MW to 1 GW.

Will pnrr help Romania meet its energy needs?

Earlier in November, the Ministry of Energy allocated EUR 30 million in non-reimbursable support via PNRR for 791.48 MWh of battery energy storage. Once delivered, the five projects will see Romania meet 20% of its storage needs, according to the ministry's announcement.

How will Romania grow its energy storage fleet?

Romania aims to exponentially grow its energy storage fleet over the next couple of years, as it works on its plan to deliver 36% of the nation's energy to come from renewables by 2030, with 8.3 GW of solar and 7.6 GW of wind, and phase out coal by 2032.

In that call, 2,660MW of renewable projects won funding while 1,000MW of energy storage projects were successful, spread across 65 projects winning a total of 427.5 million (US\$238 million). All in all, 3,095MW of renewables projects and 1,176MW of energy storage projects won in the tender. Projects will need to be operational by 31 March, 2026.

However, investment aid is only granted to new installations, without financing energy storage capacities. ...
