What is Serengeti energy's first solar project in Sierra Leone?

Serengeti Energy has started operations at what it claims is Sierra Leone's first solar independent power project. The 5 MW solar installation is located in Yamandu, Southern Sierra Leone. How much does a 5 MW PV project cost in Sierra Leone?

The 5 MW installation is the first phase of a 25 MW PV project in Yamandu, near Bo town in Sierra Leone. The project will reportedly add approximately 15% to Sierra Leone's total electricity generation capacity. Serengeti expects to start building the project's second phase in 2023. The entire project will require an investment of \$35 million.

Will a new power plant increase electricity supply in Sierra Leone?

Overall, the facility is expected to raise the operational electricity supply in Sierra Leone by about 30%. According to the statement, only 23% of the population of the country currently has access to electricity.
