How can Sierra Leone improve its low electricity access rate?

Sierra Leone is taking significant steps to improve its low electricity access rate by committing to various renewable energy projects. These initiatives, driven by the country's Presidential Initiative on Climate Change, Renewable Energy & Food Security (PI-CREF), include a major hydropower and solar PV project.

What is in Sierra Leone's energy roadmap?

A key part of the roadmap is to incorporate Sierra Leone's abundant renewable energy resources, ensuring a secure energy supply to rural communities and boosting the national economy. One of the most significant projects in this roadmap is the planned expansion of the Bumbuna Hydroelectric Dam.

How many people in Sierra Leone have access to electricity?

This comes as around 28% of Sierra Leone's population are estimated to have access to electricity, with the country targeting 85% renewable electricity capacity by 2030* - underscoring the massive potential to rapidly scale clean, cheap energy to more people.

What challenges does Sierra Leone face in developing electricity infrastructure?

However, Sierra Leone faces multiple challenges in developing its electricity infrastructure. According to the Ministry of Energy, the national electrification rate stands at 26%, with a dramatic drop to 6% in rural areas where the majority of the population resides.

Will Octopus build Sierra Leone's first wind farm?

London/Dubai, 30th November 2023 - Octopus Energy's generation arm has entered into a milestone partnership with Idris Elba and Siaka Stevens' development company, Sherbro Alliance Partners (SAP), to build Sierra Leone's first wind farm as part of the Sherbro Island City project.

The wind farm will provide crucial data on local wind patterns and energy usage, helping unlock further renewable investments across Sierra Leone in the future. Sierra Leone's energy needs are under resourced and the scarcity of a reliable energy supply is one of the key impediments to Sierra Leone's economic and social development. The country's installed power capacity per capita is among the lowest in the world with approximately 105 MW available for a population of over 7 million in 2018.

The wind farm will be located close to Bonthe, the island's main town and hub of energy consumption, with land lease talks underway. Once completed, it will generate clean power for around 2,000 homes on the island

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annually.
