



Solar energy can be installed on European tiles

Should solar panels be installed over traditional roofs?

Solar panels installed over traditional roofs can suffer from weather-related problems and compromise the roof construction. The EU-funded TilePlus project designed new roof tiles with embedded tough photovoltaic cells. This would allow millions of homes across Europe to produce their own energy.

Is there a solution similar to Tesla Solar Roofs in Europe?

Since 2017, Roofit.solar has been offering Europe a solution similar to Tesla solar roofs. The company earned the Solution for the Future 2020 award for its seamless 2-in-1 solar roof that can be found on more than 100 roofs around Europe while its modular steel roof tiles and click-roof panels are still under development but coming soon.

Will E-Tile+ Project address the solar roof market?

TilePlus project will address the solar roof market. We will argue that E-Tile+ can be installed on 13,700 roofs, while providing 142GWh in year 5 post-project.

Why should you install solar panels on your roof?

The tiles provide all the protective properties of normal roof tiles, while offering a way for residents to gather their energy directly from the sun. As the solar panels create energy where it will be used, this also reduces losses incurred during energy transport and transmission.

Could E-tile+ be used to harvest solar energy?

With E-Tile+, 20-30 million roofs across the EU could be targeted to harvest solar energy. Furthermore, our unique and patented tiles contacting approach (plug-and-play and parallel connection) provides more power output (20% higher conversion efficiency) than today's solar panels.

How many solar roofs are there?

Founder and CEO of Roofit.solar, Andri Jagomirski aimed to produce more affordable solar roofs than what could be found on the market, such as the solar roof by Tesla. Today, there are more than 100 Roofit.solar roofs in Estonia, Germany, Austria, Denmark, Poland, Sweden, Norway, Latvia and Kenya.

Solar tiles in the UK cost between £11,000 - £13,500 for the average 2-3 bedroom home while regular solar panels can cost between £5,000 - £6,000. The biggest appeal of solar roof tiles is their aesthetically pleasing design. They blend in with the design of your roof and, therefore, won't disrupt your house style.

More than 97,000 SunStyle solar tiles were installed between 2009 and 2011 on one of Europe's largest food distribution centers, the Saint Charles International market in Perpignan, turning the warehouses



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into the world's biggest building-integrated power plant.

Comparative output - solar tiles due to their size and design don't capture as much energy as a solar panel (think one single panel with no wasted space, versus several small tiles interlocking and overlapping). Solar panels can generate up to 30% more energy per square metre versus tiles.
