



Solar photovoltaic panels in Senegal

How can solar power plants benefit Senegal?

The project estimates that more than 400 jobs in the towns benefit from the existence of the new solar power plants in Senegal. Because Senegal mainly relies on imported oil for electricity, solar power plants offer a more reliable and sustainable green energy source that costs less.

How many jobs will the new solar power plants create in Senegal?

The addition of the solar power plants form part of the World Bank Group's Scaling Solar program and are funded by the International Finance Corporation (IFC), European Investment Bank and Proparco. The project estimates that more than 400 jobs in the towns benefit from the existence of the new solar power plants in Senegal.

Where are Kael and Kahone solar plants located?

The Kael and Kahone solar plants, the first financed and tendered under the Scaling Solar program in Senegal, became operational in May 2021. The PV plants, located in Western Senegal, are sponsored by Engie, Meridiam, and the Senegalese Sovereign Wealth Fund for Strategic Investments (FONSIS).

Which countries have scaled solar-backed PV projects?

Senegal is the second country to bring Scaling Solar-backed PV projects to the operational stage. In March 2019, the first solar plant financed and tendered under the Scaling Solar program was inaugurated in Zambia.

Does Senegal have access to electricity?

The competitive tendering was led by Senegal's Energy Regulatory Commission (CRSE). Although the proportion of Senegalese people with access to electricity has increased sharply over the past 30 years, nearly a quarter of the population still lacks access.

In arid northern Senegal, not far from the border with Mauritania, the Bokhol photovoltaic plant covers a 40-hectare site. The 75,000 solar panels deployed here produce 20 MW of electricity, making Bokhol the largest solar plant in West Africa.

notable local and international solar PV companies like Oolu Solar and Baobab+ operate in Senegal, using cash sales, pay-as-you-go (PAYGo), and partnerships with micro-finance institutions (MFIs). In the 2019 PAYGo Market Attractiveness Index, Senegal was the highest ranking West African country, ranking 9th out of 24 countries.¹⁰
