What are the main sources of energy in the Congo?

The main sources of energy in the Democratic Republic of the Congo are Hydropower, Biogas, and Solar. Hydropower is primarily sourced from the Congo River, with an average flow rate of 42,000 m³/s. Biogas comes mainly from both plant and animal waste, while the DRC has noticeably high solar radiation averaging 6 kWh/m²/day.

What is the main energy source in DRC?

The main energy source in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) is hydropower. It accounts for 99% of the country's produced electricity, while both oil and gas make up the remaining 1%.

What solar projects are being built in the DRC?

The main existing solar project in the DRC is a 1MW solar mini-grid with 3MWh of battery storage capacity built by Enerdeal and Congo Energy in the city of Manono, to supply the local population and SMEs. Enerkac has also developed a 1MW hybrid plant powering SNEL's Kananga mini-grid in Kasai Central (non operational in 2019).

What is the total energy consumption in DRC?

The total final energy consumption in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) is divided as follows: industrial sector (20.5%), agriculture (2.4%), and transport & public services (2.4%).

How much does solar energy cost in DRC?

Equipping the remaining two third of the population with Tier 2 access to electricity through solar home systems comes with a much lower price tag, estimated at about USD 3.3 billion. Only a few private operators both local and international - have started to get into the DRC market.

Does Congo have a potential for renewable power generation?
