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The government of Sri Lanka has entered into a power purchase agreement (PPA) with Australian firm United Solar Group (USG) for a major floating solar power (FPV) and storage project. The country's Minister of Power and Energy Kanchana Wijesekera announced the PPA on X, formerly known as Twitter, yesterday (12 December).

Sri Lanka experienced a six-hour nationwide power outage last Sunday (9), the overall economic cost of which is yet to be announced. However, the power failure that continued until last Thursday (13) has raised critical questions about the condition of the national grid, stability of energy security in the country, and its impact on the economy.

The development of the small hydro power (SHP) industry in Sri Lanka is positively considered as a success story in the energy sector. SHP industry is typically characterized by projects with capacities less than 10 MW and the economically feasible SHP potential in Sri Lanka is estimated as 400 MW.

Energy storage can be deployed in bulk or distributed throughout a power grid. A good example of bulk energy storage is pumped-storage hydroelectricity.
