Can you sell solar power to the grid?

Although many people with solar systems on their homes or businesses think that they can sell excess electricity to the power grid, the reality is that you can only sell power to the grid if you have an electricity generator's license and qualified power-generating assets.

How do you sell electricity to the grid?

One way to legally sell electricity to the grid is to register as a generator, obtain an electricity-generating license, and begin producing power. There are several ways that license generators can make power and earn income: These projects take many years of local, state, and federal approval and can cost upwards of billions of dollars.

Does Tesla sell electricity back to the grid?

In the past Tesla has offered a SEG tariff through Octopus Energy, where it paid for exported energy that came through the Tesla Powerwall battery. This tariff was closed in 2023 though. How does a power grid work?

When the power grid needs added electricity to meet demand, the liquid air is first pumped to a higher pressure and then heated, and it turns back into a gas. This high-pressure, high-temperature, vapor-phase air expands in a turbine that generates electricity to be sent back to the grid.

Can I sell power to the grid without a generator?

As we stated previously, you cannot sell power to the grid without being a registered generator. You can, however, receive billing credits for excess power from a solar system or wind turbine. However, solar storage batteries are expensive, adding up to EUR2,500 to the price of an installation.
