Are tariffs affecting the global solar trade?

The threat of tariffs on countries that supplied more than \$10 billion of solar products to the United States last year, accounting for the vast majority of domestic supplies, has caused a dramatic shift in the global solar trade.

Will tariffs hurt us solar producers?

Critics of the effort, including the Solar Energy Industries Association trade group, have said tariffs would harm US solar producers because they would raise prices on the imported cells that are assembled into panels by American factories.

How did the US & EU trade war affect solar PV?

o The trade war of the early 2010s on solar PV initiated by the US and European Union (EU) triggered a major wave of bankruptcies in China that proved to be a temporary setback for the industry. China's efforts to stimulate domestic PV deployment sustained the industry's growth and drove rapid cost reductions for Chinese-manufactured modules.

How did Chinese tariffs affect the solar industry?

o Consequently, growing cost disparities between Chinese and Western products, coupled with frequent tariff circumvention practices, undermined the efficacy of the Western tariff regimes. Ultimately, tariffs failed to deliver any meaningful development in the US and European solar manufacturing sectors.

What are Jinko Solar Tariffs?

The tariffs unveiled Monday vary widely depending on the company and country but are broadly higher than the preliminary duties announced late last year. Combined dumping and countervailing duties on Jinko Solar products from Malaysia were among the lowest at 41.56%.

Why is China a good location for solar PV equipment manufacturing?

o China's competitive advantages in mass manufacturing make it the most cost-effective location for solar PV equipment manufacturing. Moreover, China already maintains a lead in crystalline silicon (c-Si) technologies.

On January 23, 2018, the President issued Presidential Proclamation 9693 under Section 201 of the Trade Act of 1974 providing for a tariff rate quota (TRQ) for Crystalline Silicon Photovoltaic (CSPV) cells; and an additional duty for modules comprised of CSPV cells, effective February 7, 2018. The duty-free import quota will be used up by the end of 2024, and a 25% tariff will be applied to module exports to Brazil, which will negatively impact demand in 2025. The Middle East and Africa. The Middle East imported 1.7 GW of modules from China in November, down 24% MoM from 2.23 GW and up 47% YoY from 1.16 GW.

China exported 21.9 GW of modules in January 2024, a 35% increase from 16.2 GW in December 2023, then exported 21.2 GW in February, a 3% month-on-month decrease, accumulating 43.1 GW of total export volume in 2024, a 45% increase from 29.7 GW in the same period last year. These include imposing tariffs as high as 60% on imports from China and 10% on all other goods coming into the U.S. On February 1, 2025, Trump provided a look into how these future tariffs may take shape, announcing 25% tariffs on Mexico and Canada, with a lesser 10% tariff for Canadian crude oil, and a 10% tariff on China.
