Switzerland is almost entirely dependent on imports for gas. Only a little gas (biogas) is produced domestically. Likewise, Switzerland has no large domestic storage facilities of its own. It is dependent on the use of gas storage facilities in neighbouring countries.

Over the year, Switzerland covers around 15% of its energy needs with gas. About half of this is consumed for heating buildings. Switzerland is almost entirely dependent on imports for gas. Only a little gas (biogas) is produced domestically. Likewise, Switzerland has no large domestic storage facilities of its own.

Does Switzerland need grid-scale battery storage?

Switzerland, as a power transit country with strong grid connectivity, has limited demand for grid-scale battery storage despite having close to 4 GW of pumped storage capacity. The Belgian energy storage market is expected to grow from 491 MW in 2023 to 3.6 GW in 2030, and pre-table energy storage will grow rapidly.

How many residential energy storage systems are there in Germany?

By September 2023, Germany has installed more than 1 million residential energy storage systems and expects to add more than 400,000 units per year in the future. Volatile energy prices and the popularity of photovoltaic self-use have driven demand for residential energy storage, which is expected to continue to grow through 2030.

Energy storage is rapidly becoming more and more relevant due to the increasing renewable energy fraction in the grid, the rise of photovoltaics and the increase in electric cars. Swiss home energy storage product imports

Exports and imports of Switzerland in 2022 are below, along with number of countries and products. The total value of exports (FoB) was 400,057 million.; The total value of imports (CIF) was 356,235 million.; At the HS6 digit level, 4,299 products were exported to 224 countries and 4,498 products were imported from 197 countries.

switzerland energy storage market new product launch Switzerland has unveiled its most recent innovation in renewable energy: a colossal water battery. The water battery, which is called Nant de Drance and started operating, is a pumped storage hydropower plant that has the same energy storage capacity as 400,000 electric car batteries.

The volumetric energy storage density in a hydroelectric power plant is 1.1 kWh/m³, and a storage lake volume of 16.3 km³ could store 18 TWh, two times the total storage capacity of all lakes of current hydroelectric power plant in Switzerland or 13 times the Grand Dixence hydropower plant (1,570 GWh) in Valais, Switzerland.
