



Tanzania's first energy storage grid-connected project

Will Tanzania's first solar power station feed into the national electricity grid?

Tanzania has entered into an agreement to construct the country's first-ever solar photovoltaic power station to feed into the national electricity grid. The contract was signed on 29th May 2023, in Dodoma by the Tanzania Electricity Corporation (TANESCO), in the presence of the Minister of Energy, Hon. January Makamba.

How can Tanzania secure its electricity supply?

The project aims to secure Tanzania's electricity supply by helping to increase generation capacity and diversify its energy mix through the development of renewable energies (first 50 megawatts phase of a 150 megawatts solar programme) and increase the reliability of the national electricity system.

How many mini-grids are there in Tanzania?

Note: Operating projects without a specified commissioning year are not included. Today, Tanzania has 209 known mini-grids installed. With an aggregate capacity of 231,7 MW, these projects account for about 15 percent of the country's total capacity of 1,461 MW.¹⁷ Of these projects, almost one-third are either solar or solar hybrid mini-grids.

Where is Tanzania's first solar power plant located?

Tanzania signed an agreement for the first solar power production plant, amounting to 50 MW in the Kishapu district of the Shinyanga region.

When did Powergen start installing mini-grids in Tanzania?

After successfully developing projects in Kenya and Zambia, PowerGen began installing mini-grids in Tanzania in 2015. The organization will expand its portfolio further with a project financing deal it secured with CrossBoundary Energy Access (CBEA) and other financiers in July 2019.

Who owns electricity in Tanzania?

Tanzania's power sector is dominated by state-owned TANESCO (Tanzania Electricity Supply Company Limited). TANESCO owns most of the country's transmission and distribution network, and more than half of its generating capacity.

The Ministry of Energy of Tanzania has announced that the TAZA (Tanzania-Zambia) electricity transmission project, which aims to connect the Rukwa Region to the national grid, is nearing completion. The project involves the construction of a 400-kilovolt power transmission line from Iringa to Sumbawanga, designed to improve reliable electricity access ...

The overall project aims to enhance the reliability and optimise the existing fault clearance system of transmission and distribution (T& D) networks of Sri Lanka's two grid-connected electric power companies, Ceylon Electricity Board (CEB) and Lanka Electricity Company (LECO).
