

Tax rate for energy storage power supply in Sri Lanka

Will Sri Lanka reintroduce withholding tax on service fee payments?

As provided under the Corporate Tax proposals, it has been proposed to reintroduce withholding tax at the rate of 5% on service fee payments which has a source in Sri Lanka and paid to a resident individual who is not an employer of the payer of such service fee.

What are mandatory AIT deductions in Sri Lanka?

Mandatory AIT deductions will be applicable on the payment of dividend, interest, discount, charge, natural resource payment, rent, royalty or premium which has a source in Sri Lanka at the following rates from the date of the commencement of the Amendment Act.

How will Sri Lanka tax foreigners?

Amendment: Income earned from foreign sources and remitted to Sri Lanka will be taxed at a maximum rate of 15%. Encourages foreign earnings to be brought into the country, boosting foreign exchange reserves. May incentivize professionals and businesses to engage in international service contracts.

Can I deduct AIT from rent payment in Sri Lanka?

Rent - As per the prevailing law, a resident person may request the withholding agent to deduct AIT at the rate of 10% from rent payment which has a source in Sri Lanka. However, on rent payments made to a non-resident person, the withholding tax at the rate of 14% is a mandatory deduction.

Advanced Personal Income Tax (APIT) The Employers are required to remit the APIT by deducting (or as per any alternative arrangement) from the remuneration of respective employees, if such employees are resident in terms of the provisions of the Inland Revenue Act, No. 24 of 2017, with the consent of respective employees.
