

The largest energy storage power station in Porto Portugal

What is the Spanish energy company building in northern Portugal?

The Spanish energy company is building a huge hydropower complex across three water reservoirs in northern Portugal. The project will rely on 880 MW of pumped-hydro storage and is expected to become fully operational in 2024. The Gouvães reservoir in northern Portugal. Image: Iberdrola

How much energy will Porto store in 2023?

When completed in 2023, it will store as much energy as 400,000 electric vehicles: up to 20 GWh. For this reason, it is considered one of the largest batteries in Europe. The stored energy will enable the entire population of the Porto metropolitan area: 1.7 million people - to be supplied with energy 24 hours a day.

How will Iberdrola's 'Tâmega gigabattery' increase the power capacity in Portugal?

That will increase the electrical power capacity on the Portuguese grid by 6%. Iberdrola has inaugurated the 'Tâmega Gigabattery' in Portugal, a pumped hydro, hydroelectric and wind with energy storage capacity of 40 GWh.

What will a Tâmega Giga battery do for Portugal?

"When the Gouvães and Daivães plants are fully operational in the middle of this year, the large Tâmega giga battery will have enough storage capacity to supply two million Portuguese households for an entire day, and will contribute to the decarbonization and energy independence objectives set by the Portuguese government," it further explained.

How many power stations are there in Tâmega?

The Tâmega Hydroelectric Complex is made up of three power stations: the Alto Tâmega Hydroelectric Power Station, with an installed capacity of 160 MW, the Gouvães Pumped Storage Power Station (880 MW) and the Daivães Power Station (118 MW), the last two have been in operation since 2022.

How much electricity does Portugal get from renewable sources?

Portugal gets more than 60% of its electricity from renewable sources and has the objective of reaching 85% by 2030.

Portugal is supplied with natural gas through two pipeline interconnection points and a LNG terminal. Portugal has two large-scale natural gas storage facilities. The main axis of the gas network runs along Portugal's ...
