How much money does ADB give to Cambodia's energy sector?

Since 1994, ADB has awarded nearly \$200 million in loans and grants to Cambodia's energy sector and provided \$6 million in technical assistance. ADB funding has focused on expanding transmission and distribution networks and support for sector reforms and institutional capacity building.

Biomass will grow from 98 MW (1.7%) in 2030 to 198 MW (1.9%) in 2040. Battery Energy Storage Systems will account for 3.6% of the total in 2030 at 200 MW and will increase to 420 MW, comprising 5.8%. Cambodia will not have natural gas in 2030 but it will account for 8.5% in 2040 at 900 MW.

Cambodia is also set to enhance its renewable energy infrastructure with two new storage projects, according to Minister of Mines and Energy Keo Rottanak. Speaking at an August regional ministerial meeting in Jakarta, Rottanak announced the launch of a 2,000 MW battery system next year and a 1,000 MW pumped storage

In September, Cambodia approved 23 power investment projects worth \$5.79 billion for 2024-2029 to address energy shortages. These comprised 12 solar power, six wind power, one hybrid combined biomass and solar power project, one LNG-gas-fired project, one hydropower project, and two energy storage station projects.

RGP is responsible for originating and developing power ventures in Cambodia, including infrastructure-size Public-Private Partnerships projects ("PPP"s") in cooperation with the Ministry of Mines and Energy. Its first project, now a joint venture with China Huaneng Group, is Cambodia's largest hydropower facility.

The first flywheel unit of the Dinglun Flywheel Energy Storage Power Station in Changzhi City, Shanxi Province, was connected by project owner Shenzen Energy Group recently.

These projects will help strengthen Cambodia's energy security, increasing the development of domestic energy sources, and promoting the development of clean energy, it said. The projects will increase Cambodia's share of clean energy generation capacity to 70 percent by 2030 from more than 62 percent at the present, it added.
