How to do reverse charging?

Can a low-power device be charged using reverse charging?

o **Other Low-Power Devices:** In theory, other low-power devices with wireless charging capabilities, like fitness trackers or small IoT devices, could potentially be charged using reverse charging, provided they are compatible with the power output of the reverse charging device.

Can a battery be recharged backwards?

That same previously discharged battery would then be vulnerable to reverse charging, either by connecting the battery charger backwards, or by a charging system that reversed polarity (very rare, but still possible).

How do I enable wireless reverse charging?

Enable the Wireless reverse charging option. **Prepare Charging Device:** Turn on the device you intend to charge wirelessly. **Positioning:** Place the charging device on the center of the back of your phone. Avoid placing any metal objects between your phone and the charging device.

This condition leads to the battery receiving current in the opposite direction, which can damage the cells and reduce their lifespan.
