Image: Eaton. The UK government has removed the 20% for retrofitted battery energy storage systems (BESS), effective 1 February 2023. From the Spring Statement in 2022, energy saving domestic equipment such as heat pumps and roof-mounted solar have been exempt from the VAT.

Value Added Tax was introduced in 1973 as a replacement for Purchase Tax and Selective Employment Tax, as a condition of UK entry into the European Economic Community. The reduction in the standard rate of VAT from 17.5% to 15% was prompted by the recent financial turmoil in the global financial system in 2008 and increased to 20% in January 2011.

Get a VAT Refund: 3 Steps. If you go tax free shopping UK retailers will give you a VAT 407 form. As a rule, they will ask for proof that you are eligible for a refund. This may include showing them your passport. Complete the form and, with the receipt, give them to the customs refund office when you leave the EU.

From February 2024, 0% VAT will be applied to all solar storage batteries in the UK, whether they're installed as a standalone product, or as part of a solar panel system. The government introduced a VAT cut on solar panels in Britain in April 2022, bringing VAT down to zero from the previous 5% to 20% rate. The VAT cut was extended to Northern Ireland in May 2023.

Effective 1st February 2024, battery storage systems will be exempt from 20% VAT and charged 0% instead. The tax break aims to incentivise consumer uptake and support the transition to renewable energy. It applies to all battery storage ...
