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RMT builds a 37.5 MWp solar power plant and installs an energy storage system in Ivory Coast, West Africa. Boundiali photovoltaic solar power plant in northern Ivory Coast was built in partnership with the country's government, in particular CI-ENERGIES, and with financial support from Germany. It has been in operation since July 2023.

The later, Uganda has launched its feed-in tariff in 2013 but mainly micro-hydropower plants and combined heat and power plants up to 20 MW were supported. Solar was added to the policy in 2014 and the 10 MW Soroti Solar plant, the first plant to be developed under the tariff is currently under construction.

The Jebba plant is located in Niger State, in the north-central part of Nigeria and was commissioned in 1985.
