Where is solar power available in ASEAN?

The current key markets for solar power are Vietnam, Malaysia, Thailand, the Philippines, and Indonesia, which also account for more than 87% of ASEAN's population. The solar M&A scene is most active in Thailand and Vietnam - the countries with the highest installed capacities in the ASEAN region.

How much solar power is installed in the Philippines?

Currently, around 1.2 GW of solar generation capacity has been installed. The liberalized solar power market in the Philippines is governed by the 2008 Republic Act No. 9513 "An act promoting the development, utilization and commercialization of renewable energy resources and for other purposes".

Will solar power increase in ASEAN in 2025?

Power generation capacity has grown on average more than 6% during the past 20 years, with renewable sources exceeding this rate. According to Apricum's internal forecast, solar energy capacity in the ASEAN member countries is expected to increase from 23.1 GW in 2020 to 75.6 GW by the end of 2025.

How much solar power is installed in Vietnam?

Currently, around 16.45 GW of solar generation capacity has been installed. The mainly government-controlled solar power market in Vietnam, when dispatching to the state-owned utility Electricity of Vietnam (EVN), is governed by capacity quota targets announced in the PDP.

How much solar power will Thailand produce in 2037?

Under the 2018-2037 Power Development Plan (PDP), Thailand currently foresees a target of 15,574 MW of solar power generation capacity until 2037.

Solar PV capacity additions were driving the growth in renewable energy supply in Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore and Viet Nam. Although no new solar capacity was added, Thailand has begun integrating a battery storage system into a solar PV-plus-storage project, thereby facilitating the expansion of solar generation.

Increase of primary energy supply. The above drivers have influenced the increase of estimated energy supply to meet final energy consumption by 2040. The ASEAN primary energy supply - the total primary energy supply of all energy sources - is projected to increase from 592 Mtoe in 2013 to 1,697 Mtoe in 2040 (Figure 2.2).

Singapore, for example, has seen its solar energy capacity nearly quadruple between 2015 and 2018, and it is still growing.

The variable and intermittent nature of wind and solar power generation makes it challenging to integrate these renewable sources into traditional power systems and maintain a reliable supply of electricity. The traditional large-scale electricity delivery system is centralized and unidirectional.

Asia's growing energy demand has often been framed through the lens of its coal, gas or nuclear dependence, but solar power is growing rapidly across the region. Over the last decade China, India, South Korea, Viet Nam and Japan have significantly increased the share of solar power in their respective energy mixes.
