Is East Timor interested in solar power?

East Timor President Jos#233; Ramos-Horta told The Associated Press in an interview in Dili last week that his country is interested in exploring various types of renewable energy sources, including wind, sea and especially solar power. "We have plenty of sun," he said, adding that the cost of solar technology continues to fall.

Does Timor-Leste have electricity?

In Timor-Leste, the access to electricity varies significantly, from about 80 percent in the capital Dili to 10 percent in outlying regions. 24-hour electricity is available only in Dili and Baucau (the two largest towns). According to 2004 census data, at least 185,000 households lack access to the electricity grid.

Does East Timor have electricity?

Access to electricity is a modern development for many of East Timor's 1.3 million people, after much of the country's infrastructure was razed by Indonesian forces during the war for independence. Recovery was slow after East Timor gained formal independence in 2002.

What are the main sources of energy in Timor-Leste?

Fossil fuels in Timor-Leste are imported from neighbouring countries such as Indonesia and Australia. Seventy-five percent of oil imports are used for electricity production, with the remaining 25 percent consumed in the transport sector. Other sources of energy. Lighting needs are met by the use of kerosene, plant oils and batteries.

Is biomass a source of electricity in East Timor?

Traditional biomass - the burning of charcoal, crop waste, and other organic matter - is not included. This can be an important source in lower-income settings.
