How much electricity does Algeria consume?

Algeria's electricity consumption has been on the rise. From the years 2010 to 2013, it rose by 22%. Currently, the consumption increases at around 5-6% per annum. It is estimated that the country enjoys near to 100% access to electricity (compared to 57% in 1977).

Why is energy consumption increasing in Algeria?

Algeria's energy consumption has been increasing significantly, rising by 22% from 2010 to 2013, and currently growing at a rate of 5-6% per annum. Extensive need for air conditioning during the hot summer months can lead to unscheduled power outages and brownouts due to the rising demand.

A dual voltage rated appliance will display for example "INPUT: 110-240V" on the body of the appliance or

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its power supply. This means that you will not need a converter or transformer but just a travel adaptor, because Algeria operates on a 230V supply voltage, which is within the 110-240V range that the dual voltage appliance operates on.

Primary Energy Supply. In 2012, Algeria produced a total amount of 143,764 ktoe of energy. The main energy sources are crude oil (49.5%) and natural gas (50.4%). In comparison, the numbers concerning the renewable energies are much smaller and close to zero. Other energy sources such as coal or nuclear power are not used.
