Through Ghana's Rooftop Solar PV capital subsidy program, licensed SHS installers are either contracted and financed by the EC to install rooftop solar PV systems for households that meet the program's requirements, or free solar PV panels are given to the households both of which are intended to lower the cost of SHS for homeowners [13].

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
