What voltage is a power socket in Poland?

The power sockets in Poland are of type E. The standard voltage is 230 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. Check your need for a power plug (travel) adapter in Poland.

What type of power plugs are used in Poland?

What is the mains voltage in Poland?

Just like the rest of Europe, the voltage in Poland is 230 volts and the frequency is 50 Hz. Poland has standardized on type E sockets and plugs.

What type of power outlet is used in Poland?

The power outlets used in Poland are type E--the same outlet that is used in France, Belgium, and Slovakia. Type E plugs have two round pins (4.8mm diameter, spaced 19mm apart) and a hole for what is called an "Earth pin." The type E socket is compatible with most C and F plugs, which are common throughout Europe.

How do I know if my power plugs are compatible in Poland?

Do I need a power adapter in Poland?

If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter. However, if your devices use a different plug type or are not compatible with the voltage in Poland, you will need a power adapter and/or a voltage converter/transformer.

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In Poland, they are chiefly coal- and lignite-fired thermal power plants. Polish electricity exports have declined since 2015 and in 2022 Poland was a net exporter of 1.7 TWh. 78.9 TWh or 43.9% of Polish electricity production was generated at hard coal-fired power plants or from coal gases at coking works and steel plants. 47.8 TWh were generated at lignite-fired power plants, a 26.6% share.

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
