How did Podgorica evolve?

This case study presents the evolution of Podgorica through its six most significant historical stages, which are Roman (49 BCE-1474 CE), Ottoman (1474-1878 CE), principality of Montenegro and Kingdom of Yugoslavia (1878-1941), socialist period (1945-1990), transitional period (1991-2005), and contemporary period (from 2006 onward).

Does Podgorica have a central urban space transformation strategy?
