What type of plugs are used in Belarus?

In Belarus, there are two main types of power plugs and outlets: Type C and Type F. Type C: Type C plugs have two round prongs on either side of the plug, commonly known as Euro plugs. Mostly used in Europe, South America, and Africa. Type C outlets can be fit with either Type E or Type F plugs.
