In most cases, an UPS incorporates a battery, a surge protector and a power supply in one unit, but most uninterruptible power supplies also have additional filters (RFI/EMI noise filtering and Automatic Voltage Regulation or AVR) that protect your equipment in case of brownouts, without relying on the battery power.
