What is the voltage and frequency in Nicaragua? The standard voltage used in Nicaragua is 120 V, while the standard frequency is 60 Hz. Travelers from Canada, the US, South America, and all countries with a standard voltage between 110 V and 127 V can use electric appliances in Nicaragua without voltage converters.

Type A. mainly used in the USA, Canada, Mexico & Japan; 2 pins; not grounded; 15 A; almost always 100 - 127 V; socket compatible with plug type A; Learn more.

Are Nicaragua electrical outlets the same as the US?
